PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION

National Society Daughters of the American Revolution will only collect personal information that you knowingly and voluntarily provide when, for example, you order products, make reservations, or sign up to receive information. If you supply us with your postal or email addresses and/or telephone numbers online or otherwise on any of our platforms, you may receive periodic communications from us with new information. Except as described below, we will not trade, share, sell or rent your personal information outside of DAR. Additionally, we will not send fundraising appeals on behalf of other organizations.

When we send you information by email, you will have an opportunity to opt out of receiving further communication. You may also elect to stop receiving other communications by following the procedure described below in “How to Remove Your Information.”

We may use outside third parties to provide certain services. These outside third parties will have access to personal information in order to perform their functions in processing the donation, but they may not use personal information for any other purpose.

We may share your personal information if we are required to do so by law or we are compelled to do so to comply with any subpoena, order or ruling of any court, government or administrative agency.

DONOR PRIVACY POLICY INFORMATION

If you donate to DAR on any platform, we will collect and store the information you provide to us, which may include your name, address, phone number, email address, and/or other personal contact information. If you provide us with any or all of this information, you may receive periodic communications from us with information on new opportunities, additional fundraising activities or upcoming events.

When we send you fundraising appeals by email, you will have an opportunity to opt out of receiving further communications. You may also elect to stop receiving these communications by following the procedure described below in “How to Remove Your Information.”

HOW TO REMOVE YOUR INFORMATION

If you do not wish to receive information from DAR Office of Development, please let us know by using the contact information below.

- If you have received an email communication, please scroll to the bottom of the email and click on unsubscribe.
- If you are contacting us via email at Development@DAR.org, please label the email with the subject "OPT OUT". Remember to provide us with your exact name, address and national number if applicable so that we may remove your name from our list.
- Register Your Appeal Preferences: Donors often prefer some mailings and donations requests rather than others. For example, some donors wish to only receive the annual Wall Calendar while others prefer not to receive any mailing generated overseas.
